# Rules for the raft (2015)

- 1. Swimmers are required to wear a Highland Lake wristband
- 2. Raft is not open to the public
- 3. No lifeguard is on duty Swim at your own risk
- 4. Raft closes at official sunset
- 5. No boats on the raft...all boats must be tied in designated areas
- 6. No fireworks, No consumption of alcohol or use of drugs
- 7. No fishing from the raft
- 8. Extreme caution must be taken when operating a boat near the raft or near swimmers. We strongly discourage swimming to the raft.

## Violating these rules may result in arrest by Lake County Sheriff

### Dear Resident,

...in an effort to provide a summer of swimming safety, everyone is required to know the rules. Your family will be given HIGHLAND LAKE WRISTBANDS to be worn by one of your family and/or guests – but, you MUST BE HOME to allow guests on the water OR on the raft.

...Highland Lake officers and volunteers will periodically check for wristbands. Those not displaying a wristband will be asked to leave the raft and the waters...or be arrested for trespassing.

#### HIGHLAND LAKE AND ITS PARKS AND RAFT ARE PRIVATE PROPERTY

Additionally, there are two important improvements to the raft: A bird deflection device for cleanliness and a motion-detecting to discourage swimmers using the raft after official dusk.
