

Rules for the raft (2015)

1. Swimmers are required to wear a Highland Lake wristband
2. Raft is not open to the public
3. No lifeguard is on duty – Swim at your own risk
4. Raft closes at official sunset
5. No boats on the raft...all boats must be tied in designated areas
6. No fireworks, No consumption of alcohol or use of drugs
7. No fishing from the raft
8. Extreme caution must be taken when operating a boat near the raft or near swimmers. *We strongly discourage swimming to the raft.*

Violating these rules may result in arrest by Lake County Sheriff

Dear Resident,

...in an effort to provide a summer of swimming safety, everyone is required to know the rules. Your family will be given HIGHLAND LAKE WRISTBANDS to be worn by one of your family and/or guests – but, you MUST BE HOME to allow guests on the water OR on the raft.

...Highland Lake officers and volunteers will periodically check for wristbands. Those not displaying a wristband will be asked to leave the raft and the waters...or be arrested for trespassing.

HIGHLAND LAKE AND ITS PARKS AND RAFT ARE PRIVATE PROPERTY

Additionally, there are two important improvements to the raft: A bird deflection device for cleanliness and a motion-detecting to discourage swimmers using the raft after official dusk.
