Carp fishing is one of the easiest and inexpensive fish to catch.

This is all you need to Catch Carp. Throw this rig in the water and wait until the line starts to sing when you get a fish on.

1. Fishing pole.
2. Hook.
3. Sinker to get the bait on the bottom.
4. Corn.

It's that simple.
