1. President Mike Kalstrup has spoken with the County about the recent water boil notification. He has arranged for better communication in the future, should additional boil orders go into effect.
2. In an ongoing effort to improve boat storage and access, the board is attaching a link to a questionnaire to this "highlights" notice. Please take a few minutes to open the link and chime in with your thoughts and insights. Boat storage and access improvement policies are under consideration by the board, and your voice would be helpful.
