Board Meeting Highlights - July, 2016

The HLPOA board met recently for their monthly meeting. Some of the highlights of that meeting include:

- The construction on Washington has led to some damage to property owner's signs and gates. All will be reinstalled post-construction. The time line for this is fall for the road itself; trim and landscaping to be finished next spring. Lakeside Avenue will also be paved during this period.
- A reminder that HiLites are no longer being distributed in paper form. Residents are asked to check the website regularly for news and updates.
- There are three new residents on the lake. They will be hearing from The Welcome Wagon soon. New residents (as well as existing residents) need to be sure to have their watercraft tagged and numbered, and to wear wristbands at the raft.
- There will be another meeting soon with the lake health company, Clarke. To date, the milfoil have been well taken care of. Clarke is also willing to meet with individual property owners to talk about shoreline treatment, as needed. Residents who would like to use their own chemical management strategies MUST talk to the board first, as such methods could impact the whole lake which belongs to everyone.
- Please watch for flyers in the parks and delivered to your homes regarding the dangers of zebra mussels. Our lake is not impacted yet, and we need to keep it that way! The information to be distributed provides information about how to prevent an infestation in our lake.
- Residents have noticed an increase in sheriff presence around the lake. There have been no further burglary incidents. Please remember to call the sheriff if you see anything suspicious in your neighborhood.
- Marie Caviness is stepping down from her role as Easter Egg Hunt organizer. Many thanks to Marie for her years of service. We need a new volunteer! Please contact any board member if you are interested.
